

DEALING WITH

GARDEN PESTS

I have found that the best way to deal with bad bugs in the garden is to pick them off by hand and drop them into a cup of water that has a few drops of dish washing liquid in it. They die almost instantly and with consistent work, you will be able to reduce their numbers drastically for no cost.

JAPANESE BEETLES

Hand Pick and drop in soapy water
Milky Spore- Spread on the ground under plants where they are usually seen to kill the grubs.

TOMATO HORNWORM

Hand Pick and drop in soapy water
Neem Oil- not instant kill, will take a few days.
Till the soil after harvest to kill pupae.

LEAF ROLLER

BT- Spray the leaves concentrating on the underside. Repeat a couple of times to kill newly hatched rollers.

LEAF FOOTED NYMPH

Hand Pick and drop in soapy water
Neem Oil - Spray on nymphs. Will not work on adults. Safe for honey bees.

GRASSHOPPERS

Hand Pick and drop in soapy water
Trap Crops- Plant grasses & grains AWAY from your garden to attract them.
Garlic Barrier- Strong liquid garlic concentrate. Spray on all plants.

WHITE FLIES

Sticky Fly Tape
Hose off with strong water stream
Neem Oil.
